

# TACTICAL EMERGENCY CASUALTY CARE

February 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018  
8 am - 5 pm

Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (TECC) is provided through National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) and teaches EMS practitioners and other prehospital providers how to respond to and care for patients in a civilian tactical environment. It is designed to decrease preventable deaths in a tactical situation. The course presents the three phases of tactical care:

- Direct Threat Care that is rendered while under attack or in adverse conditions.
- Indirect Threat Care that is rendered while the threat has been suppressed, but may resurface at any point.
- Evacuation Care that is rendered while the casualty is being evacuated from the incident site.

The 16-hour classroom course covers the following topics:

- Hemorrhage control;
- Surgical airway control and needle decompression;
- Strategies for treating wounded responders in threatening environments;
- Caring for pediatric patients; and
- Techniques for dragging and carrying victims to safety.

CMH's TECC course meets the guidelines established by the Committee on TECC and the updated National Tactical Emergency Medical Support Competency Domains. This course is provided through **NAEMT**, accredited by **CAPCE**, and recognized by **NREMT**.

**Application fee of \$40** is required to hold your position in the course. Tuition is required by the first day of class and can be paid by cash, check, credit card, or CMH payroll deduct. Tuition amounts:

- **CMH, Cox, or Ellett employees:** Course is **free** but application fee still required for non-CMH EMS employees.
- **Volunteer** for emergency response agency: **\$120**
- **Career** employee for emergency response agency in CMH districts: **\$240**
- All others: **\$360**

Application deadline is **two weeks** prior to the start date of the course.
