

Summer 2021 EMT Academy

This class will equip students with all the education needed to be a high-performing EMT. Entrance exam testing and interviews are conducted prior to acceptance into the academy. Once graduated and licensed, employment as an EMT is the desired outcome.

- Prepared and eligible to test for Missouri Class E Driver License

- National Association of EMTs - Pre-Hospital Trauma Life Support
- National Association of EMTs - Emergency Vehicle Operator Safety
- Missouri Department of Transportation - Traffic Incident Management
- University of Missouri - Hazardous Materials Incident Response: Awareness
- FEMA NIMS 100 & 700 - Introduction to the Incident Command System

CMH EMS Education is a Missouri-Accredited EMS Training Entity that provides access to a training ambulance and high-fidelity manikins. Coursework, classroom activities, and in-class testing will focus on personal safety, teamwork, and exceptional, compassionate patient care. Extensive use of simulation and scenario education will be included. Additionally, personal work habits and fitness activities will be included to prepare students for a life-long career in EMS.

Prerequisites:

- Have regular access to a personal computer with reliable internet access
- Must be at least 18 years old before the scheduled clinical time (at least 21 years old before graduation for employment)
- Must verify complete vaccinations (TB test, TDAP, MMR, Hep B, and influenza)
- Ability to obtain a Missouri Class E Driver License
- Must not have a criminal background of felonies or drug-related convictions
- Ability to meet the functional requirements of the EMT job responsibilities

Tuition of \$750 includes textbooks, online access, two polo shirts, and testing fees. A non-refundable application fee of \$50 will be required at time of application. Fee and tuition can be paid by check, credit card, Veterans Administration Education Assistance, or CMH employee payroll deduct. Payment plans are available.

All course locations are CMH EMS Headquarters (1525 N Oakland, Bolivar, MO) unless otherwise specified.
