Buckle your seatbelt for a weekend built to help improve safety for yourself, your partner, and your patient. Three courses are combined to reduce redundancy and bring these critical topics to as many EMS professionals as possible. Over the next 16 hours, you will receive 28 hours' worth of education and certifications (if you would have taken each course separately). *Note:* No, you can't come to just one part... it's all or nothing if you are dedicated to your safety.

- Wheelchair Restraint course provide an overview of the proper way to secure passengers with special needs and their wheelchairs.
- NAEMT's EMS Safety course teaches students how to protect themselves and their patients while on the job. It promotes a culture of safety and helps reduce the number of on-the-job fatalities and injuries.
- NAEMT's EMS Vehicle Operator Safety course addresses the knowledge gat that leads to injuries and deaths, and focuses on the specific behaviors that need to be changed to create a culture of safe driving.
- The National Traffic Incident Management Responder Training Program is designed to equip responders with core competencies to address responder safety on highway incidents.
