



2023 Community Paramedic Academy

Jan. 6 - March 24, 2023: Every Friday 8:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m.

This class will equip students with all the education needed to apply for Missouri Community Paramedic License and test for IBSC Community Paramedic Certification.

Certifications and education gained after successful completion of the community paramedic academy include:

Missouri Community Paramedic license (eligible)
International Board of Specialty Certification: Community Paramedic (eligible)
NAEMT: Geriatric Education for EMS
NAEMT: Community Paramedicine Course Series

This course is built to create Community Paramedics to be a part of the Mobile Integrated Healthcare (MIH) team at CMH. Patients are referred to MIH by Care Managers, Primary Care Physicians, and Emergency Room Physicians. Once enrolled, a Community Paramedic will schedule one or more visits with objectives that include, but not limited to, assessing environmental and safety risks, performing patient assessments, conducting needs assessments, assuring health literacy, performing health education, managing non-medical needs, collaborating care planning, integrating care, providing medical treatments, and linking individuals to needed resources.

Highly knowledgeable and experienced guest instructors are heavily used in this program (currently includes almost 20 different mid-levels and physicians). Clinicals are designed to prepare you to be a fully integrated member of the advanced healthcare team. Tuition of \$300 includes textbooks, online access, and testing fees. A non-refundable application fee of \$50 will be required at time of application. Application fee and tuition can be paid by check, credit card, or CMH employee payroll deduct. Payment plans are available. Multiple scholarships are available. PREREQUISITES

Have regular access to a personal computer with reliable internet access.

Must verify completed vaccinations (TB test, TDAP, MMR, Hep B, Influenza*, and COVID*).

Currently certified in BLS CPR and ACLS.

Currently licensed and undisciplined Missouri Paramedic.

Must not have a criminal background of felonies or drug-related convictions.

Recommended to have at least five years work experience as a paramedic.
