I want to give a shout out to Bobby O'Keefe and Travis Neher that helped with the ventilator competency we did last year. Thank you both.

We are sending the new ventilators out to each station. Some stations already have the o\_two e700 ventilators. If it has been a while since you used the ventilator please take time to sit down with it and play with it. Each ventilator has a test lung with it and a vent circuit. Please keep one vent circuit at your station and mark if for training purposes. Please get with your station manager on the process for acquiring more vent circuits, vent filters (about the size of a quarter), and the bacterial/viral patient filter.

You may find that the test lung shows very high pressures when you are playing with the vent. If you have high alarm pressures then use a XL glove taped to the end of the vent circuit and shouldn't have that problem.
