- Recruit any and all EMTs and Medics that you can.
- Make sure you are checking PCS forms at the hospital before you transport and get corrected if needed. If hospital staff give you trouble, contact one of your leadership team.
- Make sure you are cleaning up your ambulance at the end of shift, lots of masks being left in the cab.
- Stroke competencies, get signed up. HealthStreams is not required before your competency but would be beneficial to you.
- Neal's office has moved by the Community Rooms.
- Crew Leader position open, Contact Alice if you are interested. Application deadline is Oct 31st.
- If you have handheld radios at home please bring them back to the Bolivar station.
- Lucas Oil this weekend will be long standbys. They have around 500 racers.
- Charts have to be done within 24 hrs, get them locked before the end of your shift.
- Make sure you are selecting the appropriate disposition in your charts. If you have questions you can ask one of the Supervisors/Managers.
